

I've done some shopping

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This game is adapted from a *Victorian Parlour* game called 'I've been to market'.

Objective: to revise present perfect tense and use English nouns.

No. of participants: as many as possible

Level: Any

Preparation: Everyone should collect some objects and put on his/her lap, at his/her feet, or a nearby location during the game.

Steps:

1. All persons sit in a circle.
2. The first person says: 'I've done some shopping.'
3. The second person (i.e. the person on his/her left) will say: 'What have you bought?'
4. The first person may answer: 'My shoes.' But he/she must touch the object.
5. The second person then says: 'I've done some shopping.'
6. The third person will ask 'What have you bought?'
7. The second person may answer: 'The chair'. Again, he/she must touch the object. But the same object must not be repeated once it is used by the previous person. That is the rule of the game.
8. The question and answer goes on in the circle and can last for a few rounds until someone has nothing to touch in close proximity to him/her. Any objects mentioned by a previous player cannot be repeated by others.

The following nouns may be used in the game. These objects can be gathered for use in a party.
